I am now using a special service for Newsletters, as you may have noticed. It is taking me a while to figure out how it works. Unbelievably, some people consider me "good with computers" ..



T-SPOT will host its usual 1st and 3rd Wednesday Fiber Arts Night (knit, crochet, felt, embroider, spin or just chat – anything goes). October 7th and October 21st, from 6pm to 8pm.

### How does free yarn sound to you?

At T-SPOT, I love having knit-up or crocheted samples, and I know you like seeing what a skein of yarn can turn into before buying it.

The problem is I can only knit so fast. I need other test knitters' and crocheters' help. No test chocolate eaters needed at this time, sorry.

Here is the short description of my model maker program:

\*We agree on the pattern and yarn to use – has to be something I need, but also something you want to keep.

\*You buy the yarn and pattern here, at full price.

\*You make the garment **within agreed time frame**.

\*If the model is up to my liking, you get **store credit** for the amount of yarn purchase (not for pattern or needles), and I keep the model for 4 months. \*Then you take the model home, and it's yours.
